## Advisory for the Low-Pressure area to the South-east of Sri Lanka

Issued by the Natural Hazards Early Warning Centre

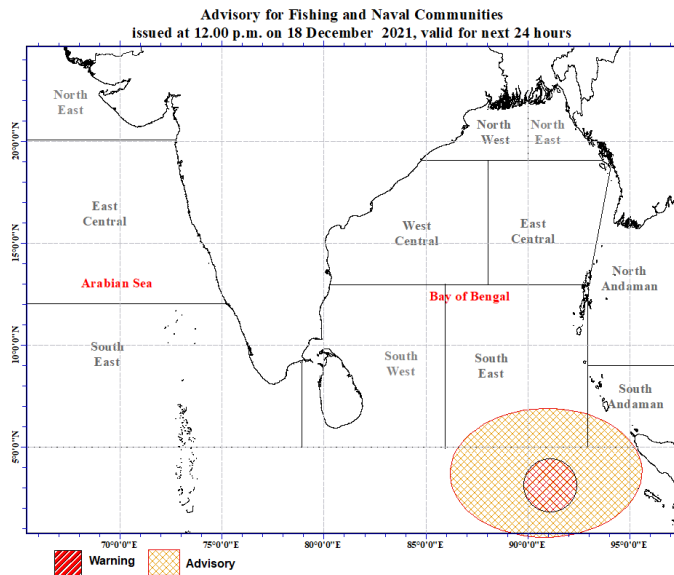
Issued at 12.00 p.m. 18 December 2021 for the period until 12.00 p.m. 19 December 2021

**For deep sea areas to the South-east of Sri Lanka.**

### PLEASE BE AWARE!

The low-pressure area to the southeast of Sri Lanka lay over the Southern Bay of Bengal. It would further move eastwards, away from the island during the next 24 hours.

Showers or thundershowers with wind speed of **(40-50) kmph** gusting up to **(60-70) kmph** can be expected over these sea areas.



### ACTION SUGGESTED:

- The fishing and naval communities are advised not to venture the sea areas between the equator and 05N (latitudes) and 87E to 97E (longitudes east) until further notice.
- Those who are out at sea over these regions are advised to return to coasts or moved safer areas.
