Issued by the natural hazards early warning center Issued at 01.00 p.m. 03 April 2022 for the period until 09.00 p.m. 03 April 2022

PLEASE BE AWARE:

Thundershowers accompanied by severe lightning are likely to occur at several places in Western, Central, Sabaragamuwa, Northcentral and North-western provinces and in Vauniya, Mannar, Badulla and Galle districts. Heavy showers **above 100 mm** can be expected at some places in these areas.

There may be temporary localized strong winds during thundershowers. General public is kindly requested to take adequate precautions to minimize damages caused by lightning activity.

ACTION REQUIRED:

The Department of Meteorology advises that people should:

- Seek shelter, preferably indoors and never under trees.
- Avoid open areas such as paddy fields, tea plantations and open water bodies during thunderstorms.

- Avoid using wired telephones and connected electric appliances during thunderstorms.
- Avoid using open vehicles, such as bicycles, tractors and boats etc.
- Beware of fallen trees and power lines.
- For emergency assistance contact the local disaster management authorities.
