A Bid Security to the value of 1% of the total value of the quotations should be submitted and it is important that the Government Procurement Guidelines are adhered to when submitting same.

Further, the name of the category and the Procurement No. should be marked on the top left-hand corner of the envelopes containing the Bids and sealed (sticker or a rubber stamp or by way of sealing wax relevant to the Institution) and sent by Registered Post addressed to the Chairman, Departmental Procurement Committee, Procurement Unit, Finance Division, Disaster Management Centre, Vidya Mawatha, Colombo 07 or could be inserted in the Tender Box kept in the Finance Division on the 3rd Floor to be received at or before 10.30 a.m. on 20 May 2021. All Bids received thereafter will be rejected.

Bids will be opened immediately after the closing time for accepting Bids and the Bidder or an authorized representative with written approval could participate on this occasion. Further, you are kindly informed that the Procurement Board retains the right to change the quantities required at the time of issuing Procurement Orders.
